This special meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners was held to discuss the following item:

- a. Discuss Drainage Issues Within the Town of Stedman with Fleming and Associates Engineering Firm and Devise a Plan of Action – Steve Fleming with Fleming and Associates Engineering met with the Board to discuss, review and implement a scope of the work involved with improving the drainage issues along Front, Euclid and First Streets. The Town was in the midst of a rainy week, so Mr. Fleming, the Mayor and the Board walked around the Town to get a first-hand look at these issues. After review of the Town and the current wet conditions, various methods of repair/improvement were discussed. Among these, repair of culverts and bulkheads, ditches, headwalls and pipes and methods of repair to include concrete work, sheet piling and others. The Mayor asked the Clerk to determine if the Town has a lateral camera that Doug, the Maintenance Supervisor can use to check the status of the pipes on Euclid, Front and First Streets. The Mayor would like to determine if the pipes in question are blocked and the condition of these pipes. Mr. Fleming discussed the need for a survey of the area. He will work with the Town to identify the project/projects and determine the design, services, fees contracts, project manager and legalities involved and submit a proposal to the Town for approval. Commissioner George stated he would contact Mr. Fleming with more information regarding the project probably within the week.
