INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Jones led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

2019-2020 BUDGET ITEMS DISCUSSED

- 3% Raises for all employees and an additional \$2,000 merit increase for the Administrative Assistant. A merit increase for Maintenance Assistant, Jeremy Byrd will be revisited upon his acquiring a CDL license.
- Purchase of a bush hog attachment for the tractor for the Maintenance Department. Should be around \$6,500, but will get a quote.
- Purchase of a newer used truck for the Maintenance Department. The current truck is a 1997 model and has had numerous repairs in the last year. Commissioner Mosley said he would check with sources on a truck purchase.
- The viability of purchasing the SVFD building was discussed, but will require further investigation and discussion.
- Commissioner Mosley discussed the possibility of adding a part-time summer employee to handle the mowing duties. This would enable the Maintenance Dept to delegate more time to other duties such as ditch clean up and drainage issues.
- Current and future drainage and repaving projects were discussed. The repaving project in the Rosewood subdivision will be completed prior to June 30, 2019. The first 2 of the 3 drainage projects for Stedman will be completed in FY 2019-2020.
- The Mayor discussed the status of the CCSO contract. The Attorney for the CCSO and the Town Attorney for Stedman are still working on contract details.
- Commissioner George spoke about the possibility of contracting with cell service providers in using the Town's water tank. This could be a substantial source of revenue if it proves feasible.
- The Town Clerk will work on incorporating these updates in the 2019-2020 FY Budget and have the budget ready by the end of May. The public hearing for the budget was set for Thursday, June 13, 2019 at 7:00pm.
