## **County Announces Operational Changes Effective March 20**

FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County will implement operational changes starting Friday to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and to protect the community and staff. Public access to citizens at most County facilities will be limited and customers will be directed to telephone numbers, email addresses and webpages.

“Our goal is to provide the best customer service possible, while limiting the exposure of our workforce and contributing to the potential spread of this virus,” said County Manager Amy Cannon.

Details for each department are available on the County’s COVID-19 Closures and Cancellations webpage at <http://www.co.cumberland.nc.us/covid19closures>. All departments are practicing social distancing and no one who is sick or showing symptoms of COVID-19 should enter a County facility.

Following the [Administrative Order](#) of the Senior Resident Superior Court Judge and the Chief District Court Judge, the court offices are operating on a limited basis. Information is available on the county’s website at [co.cumberland.nc.us](http://co.cumberland.nc.us).

The **Ann Street Landfill and all Solid Waste Management** sites will continue normal operations at this time.
