COVID-19 Update

County Has 48 COVID Cases, Commissioners Meet Monday

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Department of Public Health was notified today of three new positive cases of COVID-19, bringing the total for Cumberland County to 48.

The Health Department is conducting contact tracing investigations and will notify any contacts who fall under the guidelines for additional monitoring and testing. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) defines a “close contact” as being within 6 feet for 10 minutes or more.

Health Director Dr. Jennifer Green will provide a COVID-19 update to the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners during their regular meeting at 9 a.m. Monday, April 6.
