COVID-19 Update **Cumberland Cases Total 13, Commissioners Hold Special Meeting Monday**

FAYETTEVILLE - As of 5 p.m. March 28, Cumberland County has a total of **13** positive COVID-19 cases.

The Cumberland County Department of Public Health is conducting contact tracing investigations and will notify any contacts who fall under the guidelines for additional monitoring and testing. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) defines a “close contact” as being within 6 feet for 10 minutes or more.

Commissioners Hold Special Meeting Monday at 1 p.m.

The Board of Commissioners will hold a meeting Monday at 1 p.m. to consider amendments to the Cumberland County Emergency Management Ordinance. The county attorney is recommending the amendments to ensure the county has full authority to take actions necessary for the current public health crisis created by the COVID 19 pandemic.
