COVID-19 Update 17 New Cases Bring Total to 697

FAYETTEVILLE – The Department of Public Health has been notified of 17 new positive COVID-19 cases involving Cumberland County residents, bringing the county’s total case count to 697. To date, 23 residents have died from complications associated with the coronavirus.

The average age for residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 43 and 52% are women.

Drive-thru Testing Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The Cumberland County Department of Public Health is offering drive-thru COVID-19 test collection on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the parking lot of Manna Church at 5117 Cliffdale Road.

Test collection is conducted by appointment only. **Walk-ins are not accepted.** Click on the [Testing online self-assessment link](#) at the top of the County’s COVID-19 webpage at co.cumberland.nc.us/COVID19. Call the Health Department with questions at 910-433-3700 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays.
