COVID-19 Update **Cumberland Reports 1 Death, Total Case Count Grows to 601**

FAYETTEVILLE – The Department of Public Health reports that an Cumberland County resident who tested positive for COVID-19 has died. The person was in their 70s and had underlying medical conditions. There have been 17 deaths of county residents associated with COVID-19.

The county’s total number of positive cases reached 601 on Monday, an increase of 17 since Saturday.

Drive-thru Testing Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The Cumberland County Department of Public Health is offering drive-thru COVID-19 test collection on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the parking lot of Manna Church at 5117 Cliffdale Road.
