COVID-19 Update **9 New Cases Reported in Cumberland**

FAYETTEVILLE – The Department of Public Health reports nine new COVID-19 cases. Cumberland County's case count is now 726 with 25 deaths.

Wear. Wait. Wash.

As North Carolina eases some COVID-19 restrictions, the Public Health Department is asking people to remember three things to slow the spread of COVID-19 and flatten the curve. If you leave home, practice your Ws: Wear, Wait, Wash:

- **Wear** a cloth face covering if you will be with other people.
- **Wait** 6 feet apart. Avoid close contact.
- **Wash** your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer.
