JUST OF FEW REMINDERS: EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2019

The Town of Stedman currently offers curb side co-mingled recycling and sanitation pick up. All homes **INSIDE** the town limits are issued (1) 95-gallon recycling cart. Recycling is collected every other Tuesday. Sanitation every Wednesday. A current recycling schedule is included as well as a copy of items that can and cannot be recycled. Please follow the included list for recycling. If the Town employees see items in the recycling that should not be there, they **WILL NOT** pick up your recycling.

The Town also offers a Recycling drop off center at 193 Euclid Street next to the Museum. All items are to be separated into the appropriate bin. Items recycled at the center are glass, plastic bottles and cardboard. The area is open at all times.

Yard Debris is something that has been in question in recent weeks. At this time, the Town **does not** pick up yard debris. Thank you for understanding.

Also, white goods (washers, dryers), mattresses, furniture will no longer be picked up by Town of Stedman. This is to ensure the safety of our Town Employees. **Bagged garbage only will be picked up.**
